After a brief meeting, course workers will head out to their assignments and drivers will meet their navigators. Precisely at 2:01PM, the first car will be sent on their way. Second car will be off at 2:02PM. You'll spend a couple hours navigating the hills of Chester County, Pa, Cecil County, MD, and New Castle County, DE and then end up back at Landis Lodge on Newport Gap Pike, which is now the headquarters for the DAB!

After you find your way back to Landis Lodge, we'll have plenty of refreshment, food and prizes. Each participant gets a T-shirt generously donated by Porsche of Delaware.
