What's a *Spridget?* It all started with the Austin Healey Sprite. The original Sprite's one piece front end was dropped in favor of separate wings, front panel, and a pancake type rear-hinged bonnet. The headlamps were moved to the forward corners of the front wings, while the indicators and side lights were mounted below. A full-width grille filled the gap between the lights. The new Midget found a ready and enthusiastic market among dedicated MG fans, as it was a sports car with all the all the traditional MG characteristics—small, inexpensive, fast and safe with predictable handling. It was a fun car. The Midget sold well in its Mk IV form with only minor alterations until it was finally dropped in 1979. Some 230,000 were produced.
