Autocross Report – Duke Wilford

Not much to report from the Autocross desk this month. We are in holiday mode, and I'm sure many of you are doing the same. But planning and preparing for next year's autocross effort can't wait too long! Veterans will be shopping for or installing parts and tires. Others will be considering a New Year's resolution to try autocross for the first time. If you haven't yet come out and tried your hand among the cones, I strongly recommend you give it a shot in 2015!

As mentioned last month, BMC is potentially partnering with a marque-specific club to make one of our summer events more interesting. We are also exploring ways to get the word out to a wider audience. And, as always, we are looking to expand our portfolio of potential venues. So if you know of a club or group that you think might like to try autocross, or (better still) know a person or organization who might be willing to host an event, please let us know! All suggestions and leads are appreciated.

We had a very successful year in 2014, and paid off the Club's purchase of our new and improved timing gear. However, we need to make further investment in a registration and scoring system, which is currently under discussion. Additionally, our event costs continue to rise, in particular our insurance expenses. BMC hasn't changed our entry fees in a decade or more, but we anticipate a small increase in fees for next year. We will look at the numbers carefully to minimize the impact on our participants, and we expect to remain the region's best autocross bargain. More information will be provided as decisions are made, but I want to thank everyone in advance for their understanding and support.

In the next few weeks, we will also schedule autocross weekend dates for next year and publish our calendar. The 6-event format seems to have been successful, with consistent turnout all season. Our August event was the most sparsely attended, although there may be more one reason for the reduced driver count. Would September be a better time for Autocross V? That month is usually chock full of car shows, but weather should be more pleasant, and it also pairs nicely with our finale in October. Please give us your input on event scheduling.
