Immediately following our meeting, Jim Irons conducted our Rally School.

Autocross Report – Duke Wilford

April 12th dawned warm, mild, and sunny -perfect



autocross weather - and got nicer throughout the day. Unfortunately, our autocross season opener was on April 11th, a cool day plagued by Force 5 winds and intermittent clouds. At least it didn't rain, though it required a bunch of spare tires (and Jim Martin) to keep the

tents down!

Despite the iffy weather, BMC hosted **68 cars** at Glasgow High School –an autocross attendance record, at least within my time as a club member. We were glad to see many new names on the roster, in addition to the familiar faces. Some of our new folks were novices, but others clearly had experience. BMC welcomes all autocrossers, first timers, and old hands.

This event marked the debut of our computer-based registration and scoring system, and like the weather, that did not go off without a hitch. Hardware communication problems delayed the start and interfered with the wifibased live results. Of course, these issues didn't occur during our dry runs before the event. However, attendees were mostly patient as we worked through our teething pains. We have already taken steps to eliminate some of the hardware issues and improve reliability. We expect the live results to be available more promptly at the next autocross.

We are also making minor changes to the on-site check-in procedure that will speed the process. The goal is to provide a system that is robust and fail-safe without requiring a lot of redundant work. Toward this end, we will still have information cards, but in a reduced format from the previous version.

Having to enter or change a lot of driver data on site slows down the check-in process. Walkups and people with changes to their information will be directed to a second line, so that people who have preregistered correctly can simply grab their pre-printed card and head to Tech. **Therefore, as always, we strongly encourage you to preregister at motorsportreg.com.** Starting an account there is free, and since entry fees are not collected until the day of the event, preregistration is non-binding – you don't pay if you don't drive. **Also, please take some time to verify the accuracy of your preregistration information**. We had several people who showed up with changes to car type, number, or class, which required several adjustments to the final results. We don't mind a few last-minute changes, but having correct information up front will vastly improve the efficiency and accuracy of the event results. If you have any questions about car classing or other information, please don't hesitate to contact me before the event.

Since I was a computer jockey for much of Autocross I, you will be spared my usual name-dropping blow-by-blow description of the event. It was great to see so many people on course, even if I got less face-tohelmet time with all of you. In place of the color commentary, you may have noted that our new system offers more detailed competition results - now, in addition to your class rank, you will find your rank overall (in raw time), and your PAX rank. The PAX index works like a golf handicap – raw times are adjusted by a multiplier that eliminates the differences between the various car classes. So, theoretically, the PAX result is a pure driver's competition – your PAX rank is approximately where you would have placed if everybody was driving the same car. Also, the new software allows us to run a season-long championship in each class and PAX as well! We'll start publishing leaderboard results in the near future so you can track your progress.

If you have any videos from Autocross I, please post them on YouTube so I can link them from BMC's channel. Alternatively, you can get them to me and I will upload them. Just search YouTube for Brandywine Motorsport Club to see past and current event videos. Pictures are always welcome on our club Facebook page as well.

Although we announced our Free Rally program at Autocross I, only ONE DRIVER (Hi, Ross) took advantage of that and came out to Rally I on April 25th. Let's see more autocrossers try their hand at road rally! We're so sure you'll like it that **your first rally is free** – no charge, on the house, gratis, comp, whatever you want to call it. Give it a try – at worst it's an interesting drive on fun roads with other car folks!
