Over the winter we agreed by vote to replace all of our older tables with new ones and do the same with the "Big" traffic cones and get some new smaller ones. We also need input from The Drift Club in terms of equipment needs (radios & anything else).

Rally Report (George Alderman) – Dave Mitchell (Rally Master) talked about his upcoming Turkey Trot II Rally scheduled for Saturday November 12th at 2 PM and provided some highlights. Flyer was in November newsletter.

Property Report (Dave Mitchell) – Dave is working on organizing the Club Trailer.
