Happy 4th of July everyone!

We will have a busy month: an autocross, a rally, and another autocross. Come out and run some events. We would love to have more people come and run a rally. If you have no idea what to do during a rally don't worry. We would love to help everyone understand.

Some of our rallies have been simple straight-forward tours with clues to follow the course. When you add the TSD (time-speed-distance) elements it gets more challenging. Rally time is calculated in hundredths of a minute (.01). Why? So it can be calculated without having to convert from seconds. Distance is also measured in hundredths (or tenths) of a mile. In a TSD rally, you need to follow the course and follow one or more average speeds.

We are still working on rebuilding our rally program and training drivers and navigators. Your average speed is converted to a Minutes per Mile Factor (e.g., 30 MPH = 2.00 Minutes per mile (60/speed=factor). This number is then multiplied by the mileage traveled to get a time to cover that distance. Easy peasy. Right? Still with me? DON'T PANIC.

We have some Rally School information that was passed along to some a few months ago. If you are interested in that or would like to have a rally program for a meeting let me know, and we will make that happen.

Come and see us at this month's events. Flyers are included in this issue of the Gasline.

Brandywine Motorsport Club's
“Back to the 60s”
Road Rally
Saturday, July 15th, 2017

This is a traditional TSD rally that harks back to the way rallies were run in the 1960s. There will be just one average speed and mostly Do-It-Yourself checkpoints (with a couple of observed checkpoints included). Route instructions will range from easy to moderately difficult. There will be some “After” instructions, a few “Follow” instructions, and an occasional picture instruction. Mostly it will be an enjoyable drive through the countryside with an element of competition included.

As an additional attraction, we plan to make this rally a primer on how to run a TSD rally. We will include timing instructions telling you how to calculate your checkpoint arrival times within the driving instructions. So if you want to learn more about TSD rallies please plan to attend.

The rally route is in northern Delaware and southeastern Pennsylvania. The course is approximately 50 miles long and will take about 2 hours to complete. All roads are paved although a couple may be bumpy in places.

Start: The “Greenville Center” parking lot at Kennett Pike (RT 52) and Buck Rd. in Greenville, Delaware.

Time: Registration will open at 1:00 PM. Cars may leave at 1:30 PM.

Finish: Brandywine Brewing Company, 4019 Kennett Pike, Greenville for trophies and dining (approximately ½ mile from the start).

Cost: All 2017 BMC rallies are free of charge.
