Autocross – Duke Wilford



Greetings! In the post-New-Year world, when it's 33 degrees and snow-raining, it's a little difficult to put your mind on autocross and warm, sunny parking lots.

Nonetheless, we're gearing up for the next BMC autocross season!

As you can see by the adjacent BMC event schedule, we're trying something slightly different this year, with a break in July to divide the season in 2 parts. The first half will feature cooperative events with our Drift program, while the second half will be autocross-only events, including our annual Lofland Memorial finale event.

These events will be posted on motorsportreg.com shortly, though preregistrations will not open until closer to the start of the season. Entry fees are unchanged from 2017, at \$40 member / \$45 non-member, with a \$5 late registration fee after preregistration closes 36 hours before the event.

All dates are tentatively scheduled at Dover Int'l Speedway. We continue to look for another venue in or around northern Delaware. If you have contacts or suggestions for sites, please forward them via our Facebook page or privately to BMCAutox@gmail.com. We are in contact with the new owners of the old GM Boxwood location, but there are significant hurdles to holding events there. We will keep you informed if/when anything develops further on that front.

This begins my sixth year as Autocross Chair, and I am looking forward to another fun season. However, I am also interested in letting someone else take the driver's seat in the foreseeable future. If you would like the opportunity for a more formal responsibility position in the program, please contact me to discuss it.
