All autocross events are posted on <u>motorsportreg.com</u> now, though preregistrations are only open for Autocross I. Entry fees are unchanged from 2017, at \$40 member / \$45 non-member, with a \$5 late registration fee after preregistration closes 36 hours before the event. **Please note: because I will be out of town in the days leading up to AxI, preregistration will close at 6:00pm on Wednesday, 11 April – this is one day earlier than normal.** We will need time to process the pre-regs and get things ready to hand off to David.

One perk of Club membership is that we hold reserved car numbers over the off-season. If you are not a member (or have not yet renewed for 2018), your car number from the 2017 series has been released back into the wild. Preregister soon for AxI to recapture it. If you are planning to, join or renew online first so that you can take advantage of our members' event discount. Please give us 48 hours to process your membership and update your profile before preregistering for an event.

As highlighted by my schedule conflict with AxI, it would be good to have some redundancy in event administration. At least one person has offered to apprentice in some of the roles – thanks, **Alex Cabinian**.
