Preregistration also saves you money, by avoiding the \$5 late registration fee.

If you are planning to, please join or renew online first so that you can take advantage of our members' event discount. We recommend allowing 24-48 hours for us to process your membership before preregistering for an event.

Meeting Highlights - Jim Martin

The 6th of March, 2018 meeting was held at Skipjack's in Newark, DE. The turnout was 19 members and guests; the Executive Committee had a quorum. The meeting was called to order by Club Chair, Paul Alderman.

Membership Report (Anita Steward) – Our annual membership is now \$20/single and \$30/family. We currently have 59 members, please do not forget to renew your membership, your support is appreciated. Membership can be paid at our events and at motorsportreg.com We have 2 new members: Larry Reece and a former long-time member Rene O'Leary – (welcome back).

Financial Report (Richard Wortmann) – Richard was not available. The Club had a positive vote to authorize the payments for our Annual Club Insurance (\$1592), \$5000 to Dover (\$2500 deposit and \$2500 for our first Drifting Event of the year). We also authorized the payment of \$154 for insurance for our 1st Rally of the season; The Board also agreed that all AutoX and Drift Events for the season payments (\$350/AutoX, \$773/Drifting or \$773 for combined events) be paid on a timely basis during the season.

Rally Report (George Alderman) – Dave Mitchell (Rally Master) is lying out "The Rides of March Rally" for 3/25, Sunday. It will be a destination Rally/drive starting at the Fairfield Shopping Center, Newark, DE (Route 896 N) at 1:30 PM and the 1st car off at 2:01 PM.

AutoX Report (Duke Wilford) – The 1st Event is set for April 14th. Duke presented an AutoX budget for the season of \$700, (The Board approved the Budget and expense for the year). Duke will not be available for the start of the 1st event; we need more help to keep everything up and running. Duke is organizing a training session for our timing software (4/7) - again, we need volunteers.

Drift Report (Matt Burris) – Our 1st Drift Event of the season is set for 3/24. Matt Burris will not be there for the 1st Event, Nuri Heckrotte has stepped up to fill in for him. He will need more volunteers to help us get through this first event.

<u>AutoX & Drift:</u> We need more volunteers in both autox and drift in order to keep these events going. For insurance reasons, volunteers must be BMC members.

Property Report (Dave Mitchell) – Dave is going to get a Tow Package on one of his vehicles to assist in towing the trailer to events.

Editor (Jim Irons) –Send articles for the newsletter to Jim no later than the last Tuesday of each month.

On April 21st the Porsche Club is having a get-together at Mid-Atlantic go-cart center. Paul extended a challenge to them from BMC, come out and enjoy the fun.

Paul set up videos for us to watch during dinner.

Meeting adjourned at 7:59 PM.



The Rides of March (April?) Tour Rally

New Date: Saturday, April 21st, 2018

It is a "Sight Seeing" Tour that will have a few observational elements, one manned checkpoint, as well as a cumulative data calculation to confound. It will be about 50 miles in length and take about two hours to complete. This is **not** a time-speed-distance rally.

The tour will end at the "Greenhaus Biergarten" located at the historic Fair Hill Inn, in Fair Hill Maryland, at the intersection of Md. Routes 273 and 213 (http://www.thefairhillinn.com).

The verdant greenhouse dining venue is uniquely cozy and features a brick oven for producing savory entrees. Ordering will be from their complete menu including the fine dining choices from the historic Inn. Many craft beers and ales as well as ciders are available. A great place to have a lite bite or an early dinner.
