Brandywine Motorsport Club's Multiple Choice Rally Saturday, June 9th, 2018

A traditional observational rally that harks back to your school days when you had multiple choice tests. There will be two classes, a tour class for those who just want answer the test questions and a timed class for those who want the challenge of navigation. The rally will end at the Brandywine Brewing Company Restaurant in the Greenville Shopping Center about a quarter mile from the start location. Driving instructions will range from easy to moderately difficult. There will be some "after" instructions and a few "follow" instructions and an occasional picture instruction. Mostly it will be an enjoyable drive through the countryside with an element of competition included.

The rally route is in northern Delaware and southeastern Pennsylvania. The course is approximately 50 miles long and will take about 2 hours to complete. All roads are paved although a couple may be bumpy in places.

The event will start at the large "Greenville Center" sign at the intersection of Kennett Pike (RT 52) and Buck Rd. Registration will open at 1 PM and the driving instructions will be handed out at registration and cars may leave at 1:30PM.

Classes:

TSD: The Time-Speed-Distance class has average speeds in addition to answering test questions. **Tour**: The Tour option has no TSD requirements, just the test questions. Drive the rally route at your leisure and enjoy the scenic roads.
