Rally – We started the year with our 1st Rally on March 14th, we had a great turnout.

Autocross – Our 2nd Event, after numerous delays was held on July 18th at Ripkin Stadium. 74 Entrants, Income \$4195, Expenses, \$3829, <u>\$366</u> net positive

Drift – Our 3rd Event, after some delays was held on July 25th at Dover Downs. 47 Entrants, Income \$5424, Expenses, \$4881, <u>\$543</u> net positive.

The current BMC Treasury balance is \pm \$18,000.

Autocross



Thanks to everyone who came out on July 18 and made Autox I a huge success! I worried that coming back from a 9-month hiatus during a global pandemic would be quite the challenge, especially with the HOT low-90s temperatures and bright sun all day. But with everyone's help, we ran a very quick, smooth event and got everyone home in time to take a nap before dinner.

The new contactless check-in process proved highly effective. All but a handful of drivers confirmed their information before the day of the event, and everyone was diligent about filling out waivers and signing off on their attendance.

I want to give a special shoutout to master designer **Alex Brooke** for the course, which was tight and fast and a heck of a lot of fun. In the first half, a series of increasingly tight turns leading into a shallow straight across the big drainage ditch made the pitch change almost imperceptible. Things opened up a bit in the latter half with a slalom and a couple sweepers, but the tightly controlled exit meant that only a few stopbox cones went flying.

Next, a huge thank you to all the staff in the morning, under the tent, and in grid who really stepped up to the plate. Their sharp eyes and ears ensured we were able to solve issues efficiently to keep things running without a hitch.

Finally, thanks to all the corner workers, and especially everyone who pitched in an extra hand with setup and breakdown. They are vital to the day, and I appreciated everyone's attention to safety - we didn't have to get the red flags waving once. We couldn't have done it without them!

Registration was in flux until the very last minute, but we still managed to pull 74 total drivers split across 24 classes and about 40/60 member/non-member. Each driver was able to take 6 competition runs, with about 440 total recorded laps – yours truly even managed to squeeze in a fun run in the Club Chair's car.

Congratulations to Alden Axford Sr. in the SSM Chevy Corvette Z51 for the fastest raw time of the day at 38.900 - the only driver to slip into the 38s! And congratulations to Jason Simon, the top PAX scorer in the DS Subaru WRX STi- he really threw that thing around.

Since social distancing requirements kept us from having a post-event trophy meeting, I want to call out the multidriver class winners here as well. We're hoping to arrange trophy pickup at the end of the season for all 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place class winners from every event (single-driver classes are not eligible).

The July 7, 2020 meeting was held via GoToMeeting. The turnout was 7 members and guests. The meeting was called to order 7:34pm by Club Chair, Duke Wilford. Duke began the meeting by welcoming members and guests to today's first self-isolated online meeting.

AutoX Report (Liz Wilford)

We are booked for our first AutoX event July 18th held at the Ripkin's Stadium, and have the necessary Maryland health department approvals to proceed. Course design will be laid out per a design submitted by Alex B. Anticipating running single heat for each class for five to six runs. We are implementing social distancing measures and procedures. Information and work assignments will be set ahead of the event and emailed to drivers. Run check-in and sign-in will be located at a self-serve table. Hand sanitizer, wipes, and a limited amount of single use pens will be provided. Personal protective masks will be required. We suggest bringing your own pen for paper work and painters tape for car numbers. Unfortunately, there will not be any instructors for ride-a-long's, novice course walk, or loaner helmets. This will be an in-and-out event with no spectators, after event hangout, or trophy hand out. Event results will be posted the day after the event via email blast and online. Trophies will be handed out at the end of the season.

We obtained two new members. Membership spreadsheet and MSR is being updated regularly. Some complications of entering single and family membership has been encountered, but we are working through it.

Autocross Preregistration Fees: Entry – BMC 2020 Member - \$50 Entry – Non-BMC member - \$55 (includes 1-day BMC membership)

Classes – In addition to typical area autocross classes, we offer: Classic Street Car class – mostly-stock street cars 1978 and older.

Classic American Muscle (CAM) class - mostly-stock American Muscle, 1948 up.

Common Solo Rules and Classifications will generally be followed. We reserve the right to modify/interpret these rules to suit the spirit of the competition and safety. Please take time to research what class your car will be in prior to registration.

- NO OPEN EXHAUST Effective muffler required. We reserve the right to disqualify a car from competition if it is judged to be too loud.
- Approved helmet (M or SA 2005 or newer) and seatbelts are required. Loaner helmets will be available.
- Drivers must be at least 16* years old and have a valid driver's license. *Parent / Guardian must sign waiver of liability and be in attendance for drivers under 18.
- Parent / Guardian signatures required for workers and guests under 18.
- All contestants, workers, and guests must sign a release and waiver of liability.
- Vehicles must pass safety and technical inspection.
- No loose or unsecured items in any area. Remove floor mats from cabin.
- All cars are welcome to compete except SUVs and other vehicles that present a rollover risk.
