This is the official rerunning of our 2019 excursion clue rally to Valley Forge National Park! We figured it was advantageous to offer the event on the same day as the cancelled June AutoX.

Join us on a Q&A excursion rally set on fun/twisty roads in northern Delaware and southeastern Pennsylvania. The course is approximately 60 miles long and will take about 2 to 2-1/2 hours to complete. All roads are paved although some may be bumpy in places.

The rally ends at Valley Forge National Park near King of Prussia, PA. We encourage you to bring your family with you as we will enjoy a picnic at the park following the event. BMC will provide some individually sealed snacks and drinks but will not be providing the meal this time. We recommended that you bring your own lawn chairs and/or blankets as we may not be able to secure picnic tables grouped together due to summer busyness and/or NPS-imposed social distancing.

Autocross

First and foremost, I want to thank everyone for your support and understanding in the aftermath of cancelling Autox I and Autox II. While it wasn't really our call, your patience while we figure out how to move forward has been deeply appreciated. And especially huge thanks to everyone who suggested alternate venues!

At this time, all requested credits, refunds, and rollovers have been processed. Anyone who registered and paid for Autox I still has until June 15 to request a full refund or rollover to a later event. If you don't respond by that deadline, you will receive an automatic credit for your registration price toward any future BMC event.

Now, in extremely good news, it looks like Ripken Stadium will be available again earlier than we feared! I've been informed that the mass vaccinations will move offsite after June 22, meaning we can definitely salvage our August 7 and September 11 dates. We also had a tentative rain date for October 23 which I have asked to convert to an official event, and I'm working with Ripken management to determine whether there's any way to make this a regular 4-event season.

We also picked up a couple good leads for other venues during our hiatus. As Duke hinted above, the Coatesville Vintage Grand Prix staff have offered us some interesting options, including a potential autocross at the Chester County Airport. While we may not be able to get under contract with any other locations for 2021, I'd love to see BMC diversify our venues in 2022 and maybe even get back to 6 events per year.

Keep your ears peeled for further updates on our 2021 season, coming shortly! And make sure to update your helmets!

BMC Rally II - Rally 2 Valley June 19, 2021

A Tour Rally to Valley Forge National Park The Official 2021 Re-Running

The rally route is set on fun / twisty roads in northern Delaware and southeastern Pennsylvania. The course is approximately 60 miles long and will take about 2 to 2-1/2 hours to complete. All roads are paved although some may be bumpy in places.

Start Location: Greenville Center, Wilmington, Delaware, 19807 - intersection of Kennett Pike (Rt 52) and Buck Road. Meet at the "Greenville Center" sign for check-in.

On-site Check-in: 11:30a - PLEASE NOTE MORNING START

First Car Off: 12:00p + Car Number thereafter

Finish Location: The rally ends at Wayne's Woods Picnic Area in the Valley Forge National Park. There is a large picnic area with a nice view of the Washington Memorial Arch that we used last time. However, it is summer so it may be rather busy.

Due to safety concerns (and unclear NPS guidelines), we will not be grilling like last time. We ask that you bring a picnic lunch for you [and your family]. BMC will provide some individually sealed chips, drinks, etc. BMC will also provide some lawn games, but feel free to bring your own. You will also want to bring lawn chairs/blankets.

BMC has a sizeable canopy in case of light rain. If weather is poor, there is a tentative backup plan to eat at Infinito's Pizza in Phoenixville.

Classes: *Tour*: This rally is a Tour format with no TSD requirements, just clues and questions. Drive the rally route at your leisure and enjoy the scenic roads.

Teams will be placed into one of two categories:

Novice or Expert Classes

Based on if you have participated in more or less than 5 rallies.

Please denote during registration which class you think you should be in based on past rallying experience (or lack thereof).

• "Ran This Before" Class

Based on if you ran the BMC event Rally to the Valley in October 2019.

Please place yourself into this category if you ran this event in 2019 (even if you think you won't remember the route). The route will vary slightly as there are no foreseen detours this time.

Cost: BMC members: \$5 per person / Non-members: \$10 per person

RSVP: Please RSVP so we can have enough route instructions at the event.
