Preregistration is still open for AxIV – about 20 spots are still open as of this writing. HeroFest is something different for us. As part of a benefit event for Street Heroes Frontline, a nonprofit group supporting veterans and first responders, BMC will be hosting an "Intro To Autocross" at the festival and car show. We could still use a few volunteers - more details can be found in the Autocross column.

On 17 September, the Sixth Annual Coatesville Vintage Grand Prix went off without any major hitches, thanks to everyone who pitched in to keep the track day going smoothly. Drivers and riders praised BMC's all-volunteer crew of tech inspectors, marshals, and corner workers. BMC Meeting Highlights

The September 6, 2022 meeting was held at Deerhead Hotdogs, Newark DE. The meeting was called to order 7:00 PM by the Club Chair, Duke Wilford who welcomed all out. We had 13 members and 2 guests.

Treasurer's report (PJA)

\$43.6 K in account that includes Coatesville GP entries, our expenses will come out of those funds.

Membership (Duke)

We have members, (~140); workers for Coatesville GP will get their memberships covered for next year.

Property Report (George & Duke)

Trailer requested for Coatesville GP cones and Canopies needed. Also needed for October 8th and 9th at Ripken for 2 events

Coatesville GP (Duke)

We have 29 cars and 15 motorcycles signed up and a few more days to register. There are a few that have a conflict with the Watkins Glen vintage weekend and cannot afford any issues before that weekend so have declined to attend. Fox29 news filmed a spot with some of the cars and bikes attending to be used Thursday Sept. 8th 6:30 PM. There was also an interview with the radio car show from NJ that rebroadcasts on the Performance Motorsport Network.

We have 37 volunteers and could use 8-10 more. Paddock and tech is opening 5:30 AM and all paddock workers need to be there ahead of time. Corner workers need to be ready to hit the track 8:00AM and recon laps are 8:30AM. More information will get sent out for everyone signed up to work.

Autocross (Liz)

AutoX IV is all set for October 8, currently 40 cars. This event will be the Lofland Trophy event for the year. We are looking for some added helmets for loaner use. We have L & XL but need S and M.

Liz introduced our guests Gary and Brett from Street Heroes Frontline, They have an event October 9th at Ripken and would like our help setting up a small autocross course. The course setup will be on the section of the parking lot closest to I-95 so that crowd control is easiest. BMC instruction will be provided for all runs to keep the drivers under control. Their insurance will cover us and we are strictly handling the autocross section. Medics will be on site and volunteers will be feed and watered. We also would have some discounts. for the workers that could be used on a future event. The event runs from 10:30 AM to 5:00 PM; the Autocross would run from 11:00 to 3:00 We would charge \$5.00 per run with a cap of 8 per driver. We will be donating from our proceeds to the group to benefit Veterans and Front-Line Workers, pending Board approval.

It's also your ONLY shot at the FTD Lofland Memorial Cup, traditionally awarded to the driver with the fastest raw time at the final competition event of the season.

Autocross Preregistration Fees:

Entry - BMC 2020 Member - \$50

Entry – Non-BMC member - \$55 (includes 1-day BMC membership)

Classes – In addition to typical area autocross classes, we offer:

Classic Street Car class - mostly-stock street cars 1978 and older.

Classic American Muscle (CAM) class - mostly-stock American Muscle, 1948 up.

Common Solo Rules and Classifications will generally be followed.

We reserve the right to modify/interpret these rules to suit the spirit of the competition and safety. Please take time to research what class your car will be in prior to registration.

- NO OPEN EXHAUST Effective muffler required.
 - We reserve the right to disqualify a car from competition if it is judged to be too loud.
- Approved helmet (M or SA 2010 or newer) and seatbelts are required.
- Drivers and Passengers must be at least 16 years old*. Drivers must have a valid driver's license. *Parent / Guardian must sign waiver of liability and be in attendance for drivers under 18.
- Parent / Guardian signatures required for workers and guests under 18.
- All contestants, workers, and guests must sign a release and waiver of liability.
- Vehicles must pass safety and technical inspection.
- No loose or unsecured items in any area. Remove floor mats from cabin.
- All cars are welcome to compete except SUVs and other vehicles that present a rollover risk.
