As of this writing, the first warm days of 2014 are hinting at the spring to come. With them comes the rush to accomplish those off-season tasks we all assumed there was plenty of time for... or is that just me?

At our February meeting, the Executive Committee voted in favor of investing in new wireless timing gear for the 2014 season. If all goes well, by our first event, we should be operating with new equipment that is capable of timing multiple cars, and will allow us more flexibility in start/finish locations. We're excited about this development!

Speaking of the first event, here is our preliminary autocross schedule for 2014: 12 April – 17 May – 14 June – 19 July – 16 August – 11 October.

The sharp-eyed among you will notice that this list is slightly longer than usual. An informal poll at several previous club meetings indicated that there is support for adding more events to the calendar. Although locations are still being finalized, it appears that we will have at least one new venue for season. Stay tuned for announcements as we receive approvals.

As soon as we have confirmed locations, our events will open for preregistration on <a href="https://www.motorsportreg.com">www.motorsportreg.com</a>.

All dates are Saturdays, because another informal poll showed an overwhelming preference for Saturday events. If this proves to be an issue, we will consider adjusting some later-season events to Sunday. Please feel free to contact me if you have any comments.

With recent changes to the SCCA Solo II rulebook, please take a few minutes to research where your car will wind up for the 2014 season. Although we typically make minor adjustments, we largely mimic the SCCA's classing structure. It helps reduce the registration-desk scramble if you already know what class your car should be in.

Also, to get everyone excited for the upcoming season, our March club meeting will have indoor cart racing to follow – please see the details elsewhere in this Gasline. Come on out and have a good time!

## Secretary's Report - Jim Martin

The 4<sup>th</sup> February 2014 meeting was held at the Charcoal Pit on Kirkwood Highway. The turnout was 21 members; thanks to all that showed up. Your input and support inspires us for all the work that we are putting in. The meeting was called to order by Paul Alderman at 7:01 PM.

Treasurer's Report (Willis Weldin) – At the end of January, we had \$7,492.29 in our Club account and we currently have 83 members. Don't forget to renew your membership, last year's membership expires on March 1st, as a result, our membership number in March will reflect only those members that have renewed their membership.

Rally Report (George Alderman) – The March Lamb Rally is on schedule for Saturday, April 5; details are on our website. The Annual Braille Rally that we co-host with the Porsche Car Club is set for April 27; details are still being worked out.

Autocross Report (Duke Wilford) - With the help of Pat Phalan, we are approaching Dover Downs with an Optional Payment Plan that will not require us to lose money if we stage another event there. We are also planning on approaching Delaware Park. We are currently waiting to hear back from the Principal at Glasgow High School. We currently have Keene Elementary as a site but we are looking for bigger sites. We are also looking at updating our timing equipment that will allow us to have more than one car on the course at a time.

Tentatively, we have set 4/12 or 4/13, 6/14 or 6/15, 8/9 or 8/10, and 10/11 or 10/12 for Autocross dates. We are also looking at expanding to one Autocross per month. As we find available sites, we will firm up the schedule.

Property Report (Mark Schroy) – Mark is planning on setting up a Video Interview on March 7<sup>th</sup> of long time members so we can capture some of the our Club History. It will become available on our Website at some future date.
