<u>AutoX Report</u> (Duke Wilford) – Our 1st AutoX/ Drifting Event is set for April 29th at Dover. Our 2nd dual Event is set for May 13th at Dover.

Our new K&K policy will cover Dover Events saving us about \$1400 per event. Help us get the word out. <u>Please help us find other lots particularly in New Castle</u> <u>County, contact Duke. We have no backup to Dover.</u>

<u>**Drift Rally**</u> (Matt Burris) – Is planning on 5 events in 2017. With their help, we are combing our AutoX events with the Drifting Events at Dover.

Autocross – Duke Wilford



We are just a few days from our Autocross season opener, and as I write this, the weather is cool and rainy. Fortunately, the forecast is for great autocross weather on Saturday! Response has been good and we have over 50

drivers preregistered. We're warming up the timing equipment and dusting off the cones.

Our first autocross / drift for 2017 is 29 April, at Dover Speedway. Drift will have the front lot, with autocross using the backside lots. Autocross / Drift II will be 13 May, also at the Speedway. When at this location, the programs will switch between main and back lots – autocross will use the front lot in May.

Because of Firefly and NASCAR activity in June, the Speedway is not available. As this is currently our only venue, we will not have a June event. We are looking at extending our autocross season into October again in order to provide 6 events. Future dates are:

• 22 July at Dover Speedway – AutoX / Drift III

- 12 August at Dover Speedway AutoX / Drift IV
- 09 September at Dover Speedway AutoX / Drift V
- 14 October at Dover (tentative) AutoX / Drift VI

We are also considering the possibility that either AutoX V or VI will be autocross-only, utilizing all the available lots to maximize our course. This will depend upon the economics of the season, since our rent and insurance costs have radically increased.

Preregistration for Autocrosses I and II, and Drift II, is open now at <u>www.motorsportreg.com</u>. Future events are on the calendar and will open for preregistration on a rolling basis. As mentioned last month, we are now taking payments online via www.motorsportreg.com as well. Payment is due at time of preregistration, but cancellations can be refunded as a credit toward a future event if you give us advance notice. We are making this change in order to speed up the on-site check-in process and to reduce the large number of no-shows we've experienced in the past. We will still accept walkup registrations for Autocross on the day of the event, but these will be subject to a \$5 late registration fee.

People have asked about the possibility of participating in both the autocross and drift events on the same day. Although it is theoretically possible, drivers must pay separate entry fees for each event. Also, logistically speaking, it is challenging for the driver. Autocross depends upon each driver fulfilling their role as course worker too. Although 1/3 of each heat is free, maximizing the number of runs for everybody requires prompt changeover between run groups in order to avoid delays. From an autocross perspective, I don't recommend trying to split your day – consider alternating events instead.
